Additional approval by OUP and Buildings and Grounds is required prior to installing evergreen perennials, herbaceous perennials, bulbs, vines, ferns, and ornamental grasses. Additional approval from the Campus Landscape Architect or University Arborist is required prior to installing flowering dogwood.
