#### Part III- Supporting Information

- A. Please describe your sustainability initiative and attach supporting documentation.

  This initiative plans to replace two benches by Cochrane Hall with a 10-loop bicycle rack. According to the Virginia Tech Department of Alternative Transportation's 2019 bike census, the Cochrane Hall bike rack has 100% utilization plus bikes locked to nearby benches and 100%+ utilization at nearby racks. These benches often have bicycles locked to them, damaging the benches, and making them unusable when obstructed by bikes. Removing these two specific benches should not disrupt the ability to enjoy the outside area because there are at least 4 other benches nearby available for use, plus other benches around in the courtyard and around the Dining Hall. Adding bike racks fills the demand for student bicyclists attending the dining and residence halls, while also helping to maintain the outside appeal and appearance of the courtyard.
- B. How does this initiative help to achieve the goals of the Virginia Tech Climate Action Commitment Resolution and Sustainability Plan?
  - The courtyard between Cochrane, West Ambler Johnston, and West End is frequently used by students due to its proximity to two residence halls and a dining hall. Increasing bike infrastructure encourages students to bike as a form of transportation. Increasing bike infrastructure also normalizes bicycle culture, encouraging more students to utilize bicycles as an alternative form of transportation around campus. More students on bikes can help to decrease carbon emissions, as fewer people would be driving. Ultimately, helping Virginia Tech to reach its sustainability goals. This sustainable initiative towards bikes correlates with the following Climate Action Policies: Policy Point 1, Policy Point 3, and Policy Point 11. Increased bike usage on campus improves transportation energy efficiency on campus by reducing carbon and energy spent via vehicular commuting (Policy 3 & 11). Sustainability initiatives to increase bicycle traffic also helps Virginia Tech meet its goal to be a leader in campus sustainability (policy 1).

The requested costs are based off a price quote for Renaissance Site bicycle rack and bicycle shelter:  One 8-Loop Bicycle Rack: \$1,000  Concrete Pad: \$2,000  Bike Shelter: \$8,000  Landscaping: \$500  Contingency (~10%): \$1,500  Total: \$13,000	Furnishings for the bike 5-loop
